About the Scheme

This new and innovative scheme provides healthcare scientists with the unique opportunity to spend one year working in a non-clinical role at the centre of NHS England and NHS Improvement with the most senior leaders and teams in healthcare and healthcare science.

Clinical fellows lead on projects that directly contribute to national healthcare priorities and develop a range of enhanced skills required for effective leaders including:

leadership | management | strategy | project management | policy development

The scheme is sponsored by the Chief Scientific Officer of NHS England and NHS Improvement and is managed by the Faculty of Medical Leadership and Management.
